

Summer 2023 Program Details

- Maximum of 50 Global School students can be selected.
- Application Deadline: Thursday 16th March (14:00). You must submit completed AND signed application to Global School office by the
 deadline.
- Please read the contract (in Korean) very carefully. You must check every box, and both you AND a parent sign the form.
- You will be paid scholarship <u>after</u> the course has finished and <u>only if you pass the course</u>.
- Required application documents:

- You must also register for Hallym 'Global Language and Culture Course' (2 credit program) and pay the associated summer program credit fee of w150,000 by the deadline.

Cost of program (including lectures + campus single room accommodation + trips): 1,427 pounds Approximately w2,170,000 (assuming 40+ students are selected).

Additional costs: Students must purchase their own flight tickets + insurance + spending money

Deadline To Apply

Thursday 16th March (14:00)

No extension under any circumstance > as costs for program (per student) is based on total number.

The costs shown to you are based on 40-50 Global School students applying for this program.

Application documents must be printed, signed (including parent) and given to Global School Office (not me) by the deadline.

Payments Once Selected

If your application is successful:

- You must pay the University of York <u>individually</u> using an online payment system (you can use your parents credit card if you wish).
- Full payment will be due late April/early May.
- You should also book flights quickly (once your place is confirmed) to get the best price.
- You must also buy insurance before you travel + pay the 2 Credit Hallym Summer Fee (w150,000)
- I will provide you with an arrival guide to help you and we will have other orientations before you finish at Hallym for the vacation (please attend!)
